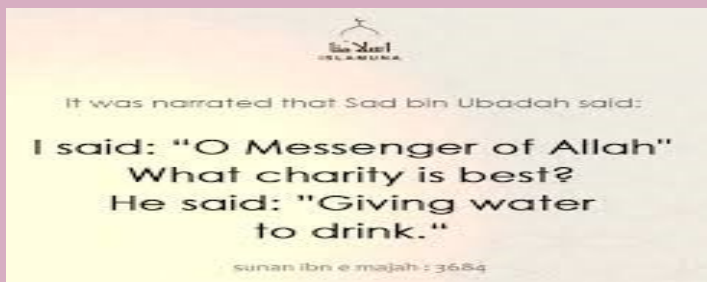
It's been a very busy week for children at Al Khair Prep School, they have been participating in activities during anti bullying week and wearing odd socks!

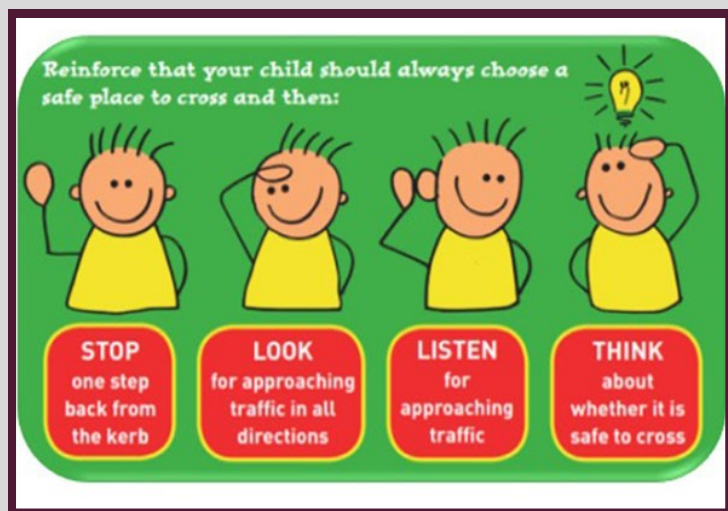

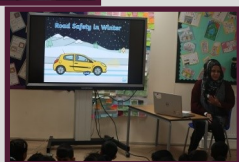

Odd Socks Day

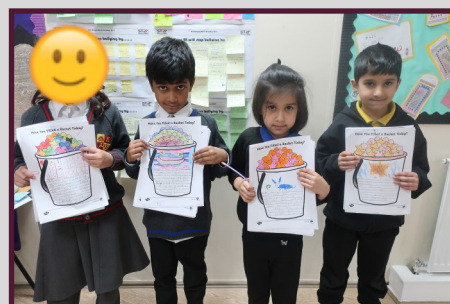

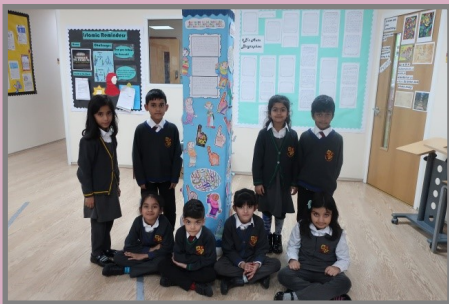
Islamic Posts

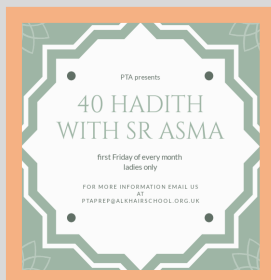
Islamic Reminder

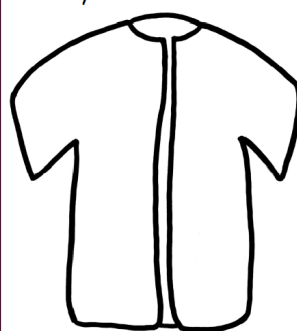
