SPORTS LEADER COURSE AT AL-KHAIR: DEVELOPING AS CONFIDENT, HEALTHY LEADERS THROUGH SPORT AND PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

In our drive to widen our curriculum and provide opportunities for our students to develop vocational skills, we have begun providing a Level 1 Sports Leadership course for our students aged 12 and over. They will spend the next few weeks as well as getting the opportunity to learn about the theory of sports leadership as well as its practical applications.

The qualifications is designed to use sport and physical activity to help young people develop and hone their leadership skills whilst helping themselves and others stay physically active.
